Acts 4:10 ERV

### **PRAY FOR GOD'S HEALING POWER IN THE CHURCH**

Acts 4:30 KJVS

By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.

Acts 8:6-7 KJVS

And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did. [7] For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them : and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.

### **3 THINGS YOU MUST BELIEVE TO RECEIVE WHAT JESUS PURCHASED FOR YOU**

1. YOU HAVE TO MAKE A DECISION TO BELIEVE WHAT GOD SAYS IN HIS WORD.

#### ABOUT FORGIVENESS OF SIN

Romans 10:9 NLT

If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

#### ABOUT DIVINE HEALING

Matthew 8:17 KJVS

That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.

2. MUST BELIEVE IN THE POWER OF GOD IN YOU

Colossians 1:27 NLT

For God wanted them to know that the riches and glory of Christ are for you Gentiles, too. And this is the secret: Christ lives in you. This gives you assurance of sharing his glory.

1 John 4:4 KJVS

Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

*FAITH ACTIVATES THE POWER OF GOD*

*FAITH IS THE NECESSARY INGREDIENT TO RECEIVE BLESSINGS FROM GOD IN REALITY*

**POWER POINT:** ONCE YOU HAVE ACTIVATED THE HEALING POWER OF GOD NEVER ENTERTAIN THOUGHTS OF DOUBT.

**NOTE: CONFESSIONS YOU SHOULD NEVER MAKE**

\* IT'S NOT WORKING. WHY IS IT TAKING SO LONG?

\* IF YOU GIVE LIFE TO THESE THOUGHTS BY SPEAKING THEM OUT. YOU STOP THE HEALING POWER OF GOD FROM COMPLETING THE WORK.

Hebrews 10:23 KJVS

Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)

**NOTE: CONFESSIONS YOU SHOULD MAKE**

\*THE WORD IS WORKING IN ME.

\*GOD IS PERFECTING EVERYTHING CONCERNING ME.

\*THE HEALING POWER OF GOD IS CAUSING EVERY PART OF MY BODY TO FUNCTION PROPERLY

3. YOU MUST BELIEVE YOU HAVE BEEN GIVEN AUTHORITY BY JESUS TO HEAL THE SICK

Mark 16:15-18 KJVS

And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. [16] He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. [17] And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; [18] They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

John 4:46-53 KJVS

So Jesus came again into Cana of Galilee, where he made the water wine. And there was a certain nobleman, whose son was sick at Capernaum. [47] When he heard that Jesus was come out of Judaea into Galilee, he went unto him, and besought him that he would come down, and heal his son: for he was at the point of death. [48] Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe. [49] The nobleman saith unto him, Sir, come down ere my child die. [50] Jesus saith unto him, Go thy way; thy son liveth. And the man believed the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way. [51] And as he was now going down, his servants met him, and told him, saying, Thy son liveth. [52] Then enquired he of them the hour when he began to amend. And they said unto him, Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him. [53] So the father knew that it was at the same hour, in the which Jesus said unto him, Thy son liveth: and himself believed, and his whole house.
