#### 1. AWAITING THE NEW KING

# 2. THE BIRTH ANNOUNCEMENT OF JESUS THE SOON COMING KING

Luke 1:26-33 - 26"And in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God unto a city of Galilee, named Nazareth, to a virgin espoused 27 to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David; and the virgin's name was Mary. 28 And the angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, thou that art highly favoured, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women. 29 And when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and cast in her mind what manner of salutation this should be. 30-And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God. 31-And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS. 32-He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David: 33-and he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end."

# 3. THE CONCEPTION OF JESUS - THE WORD MADE FLESH

Luke 1:34-38 AMP - 34"Mary said to the angel, "How will this be, since I am a virgin and have no intimacy with any man? 35" Then the angel replied to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you [like a cloud]; for that reason the holy (pure, sinless) Child shall be called the Son of God."36 "And listen, even your relative Elizabeth has also conceived a son in her old age; and she who was called barren is now in her sixth month. 37For with God nothing [is or ever] shall be impossible. 38" Then

Mary said, "Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; may it be done to me according to your word." And the angel left her."

# 4. THE BIRTH OF CHRIST JESUS OUR SAVIOR OUR LORD -THE KING IS HERE

Luke 1:1-19 - 1"And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed. 2 (And this taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.) 3 And all went to be taxed, everyone into his own city. And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; 4 (because he was of the house and lineage of David:) 5 to be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child. 6 And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered. 7 And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn." 8 "And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. 9 And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid. 10 And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you

good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. 11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord. 12 And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger. 13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying," 14 "Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, good will toward men. 15 And it came to pass, as the angels were gone away from them into heaven, the shepherds said one to another, let us now go even unto Bethlehem, and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord hath made known unto us. 16 And they came with haste, and found Mary, and Joseph, and the babe lying in a manger. 17 And when they had seen it, they made known abroad the saying which was told them concerning this child. 18 And all they that heard it wondered at those things which were told them by the shepherds. 19 But Mary kept all these things and pondered them in her heart. 20-And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told unto them."

## 5. MINE EYES HAVE SEEN THE KING OF GLORY

Luke 2: 21-40 - 21"And when eight days were accomplished for the circumcising of the child, his name was called JESUS, which was so named of the angel before he was conceived in the womb." 22 "The time came for Mary and Joseph to do

what the Law of Moses says a mother is supposed to do after her baby is born. They took Jesus to the temple in Jerusalem and presented him to the Lord, 23-just as the Law of the Lord says, "Each first-born baby boy belongs to the Lord. 24-"The Law of the Lord also says parents have to offer a sacrifice, giving at least a pair of doves or two young pigeons. So that is what Mary and Joseph did." 25-" At this time a man named Simeon was living in Jerusalem. Simeon was a good man. He loved God and was waiting for him to save the people of Israel. 26-God's Spirit came to him and told him that he would not die until he had seen Christ the Lord. 27-When Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the temple to do what the Law of Moses says should be done for a new baby, Holy Spirit told Simeon to go into the temple. 28-Simeon took the baby Jesus in his arms and praised God, 29- "Lord, I am your servant, and now I can die in peace, because you have kept your promise to me. 30-With my own eyes I have seen what you have done to save your people, 31-and foreign nations will also see this. 32-Your mighty power is a light for all nations, and it will bring honor to your people Israel. 33-" Jesus' parents were surprised at what Simeon had said. 34-Then he blessed them and told Mary, "This child of yours will cause many people in Israel to fall and others to stand. The child will be like a warning sign. Many people will reject him, 35-and you, Mary, will suffer as though you had been stabbed by a dagger. But all this will show what people are really thinking." 36- "Anna, a prophet, was also there in the Temple. She was the

daughter of Phanuel from the tribe of Asher, and she was very old. Her husband died when they had been married only seven years. 37-Then she lived as a widow to the age of eighty-four. She never left the Temple but stayed there day and night, worshiping God with fasting and prayer. 38-She came along just as Simeon was talking with Mary and Joseph, and she began praising God. She talked about the child to everyone who had been waiting expectantly for God to rescue Jerusalem. 39-When Jesus' parents had fulfilled all the requirements of the law of the Lord, they returned home to Nazareth in Galilee. 40-There the child grew up healthy and strong. He was filled with wisdom, and God's favor was on him."
