

Praying God's Will
The Prayers That Are Always Answered

Question: What does the will of God mean? What does it mean to pray His will?

The will of God is God's desire for us. His plan for us. It's what he has pre-ordained to happen in our live. It's what He want.

Praying the will of God means to pray what Gods desire. To Pray his pre-ordained plan for mankind or over any situation. When we Pray His will we are saying "Lord, make This what you desire it to be.

The bible is God's known (revealed) will to mankind. It's His general cross the board purpose for the believer

NOTE: Praying the will of God is not a feeling or an emotional connection. Its an instruction from Jesus. Jesus told us how to pray, who to pray to and what to say.

Matthew 6:5-10 NJKV

5.And when you pray, you shall not be like the hypocrites. For they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the corners of the streets, that they may be seen by men. Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward. 6But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who *is* in the secret *place*; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly. 7And when you pray, do not use vain repetitions as the heathen *do*. For they think that they will be heard for their many words.8"Therefore do not be like them. For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him. 9In this manner, therefore, pray:Our Father in heaven,Hallowed be Your name.10Your kingdom come.Your will be doneOn earth as it is in heaven.

(PEV)

Jesus said, "Don't pray like those people that want everyone to think they are good, even though they are not good. They like to stand up and pray in the meeting houses and on the busy street corners, so that lots of people can see them praying. They want to hear people say, 'That's a good person.' But listen, that is all those people will get. God will not give them anything good for doing that."

6And Jesus said, "I'll tell you the right way to pray. Go away from other people to a place where you can be alone, like go into a little room in your house and close the door. There you can pray to God, your father. He is in that secret place. And he sees what you do. He will listen to you, and he will be properly good to you for respecting him.

7And when you pray, don't keep on talking on and on, with lots of words that don't mean anything. People that don't know God, they do that. They think that if they talk a lot, God will hear them. But they are wrong. 8Don't be like them. God, your father, knows what you need already, even before you ask him.

9So pray like this,

'God, our father, you live in heaven.

We want everyone to respect you.

10We want you to be everyone's boss.

We want everyone in the world to do what you want

Prayer is not a show but a heart connection between me and God

Our Prayer reward comes from God not man. Our Reward is God answering our prayers

* I make a heart connection secretly with God and he reward openly.

God is not deaf. The 1st time we pray He hears us. Vain repetition means babbling on with no heart connection. Say the same words over and over thinking God will hear me. It means I don't know the will of God and I'm begging him to do something in unbelief.

Daniel 10:12NLT

12Then he said, "Don't be afraid, Daniel. Since the first day you began to pray for understanding and to humble yourself before your God, your request has been heard in heaven. I have come in answer to your prayer.

We pray to our Father which is in heaven

In order for God's will to be done in the earth. You and I must pray it.

Jesus said pray God's will be done in earth as it is in heaven

We pray that your kingdom will come—
that what you want will be done here on earth, the same as in heaven. (ERV)

Manifest your kingdom realm,
and cause your every purpose to be fulfilled on earth,
just as it is in heaven. (TPT)

God want earth to be like Heaven

Example: When someone dies and they leave a will, that will is honored when it goes through the proper legal procedures. If it doesn't then the will won't be honored. It won't happen

As believer God gave us his will, but it must go through proper legal procedures so it can come to pass. The procedures are consistent, heartfelt, faith-filled prayers.

1 John 5:14-15NLT

And we are confident that he hears us whenever we ask for anything that pleases him. 15And since we know he hears us when we make our requests, we also know that he will give us what we ask for.

(TPT)

Since we have this confidence, we can also have great boldness before him, for if we ask anything agreeable to his will, he will hear us. 15And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we also know that we have obtained the requests we ask of him.

1. Praying God's will brings confidence

praying what He desire not what I desire.

We can ask God anything according to His will Anything in line with his word and He Will hear us and give us exactly what we ask for

Note: The word of God is the will of God

Jeremiah 1:11-12

11The word of the Lord came to me, saying, “Jeremiah, what do you see?” And I said, “I see the branch of an almond tree.” 12Then the Lord said to me, “You have seen well, for I am [actively] watching over My word to fulfill it.”

When we pray his will God will watch over it to bring it to pass. JUST KEEP ON PRAYING

2. Praying God's will Bring Peace.

We don't pray the problem we pray the solution. The solution is the word of God concerning that.

Philippians 4:6-7TPT

Don't be pulled in different directions or worried about a thing. Be saturated in prayer throughout each day, offering your faith-filled requests before God with overflowing gratitude. Tell him every detail of your life, 7then God's wonderful peace that transcends human understanding, will guard your heart and mind through Jesus Christ.

TLB

Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything; tell God your needs, and don't forget to thank him for his answers. 7 If you do this, you will experience God's peace, which is far more wonderful than the human mind can understand. His peace will keep your thoughts and your hearts quiet and at rest as you trust in Christ Jesus.

Don't worry about nothing but pray God's will about...

We thank God for answering our prayers before we even make a request.

This is conditional. We must do our part 1st then God will do his part.

3. Praying God's will bring salvation to the Lost

People receive the gospel when we pray God's will for them.

We push back the forces of darkness over their lives.

Remember: The Key to Get our Prayer answered is praying was Good want not what we want

1 Timothy 2:1-6

I urge you, first of all, to pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them. 2Pray this way for kings and all who are in authority so that we can live peaceful and quiet lives marked by godliness and dignity. 3This is good and pleases God our Savior, 4who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth.

God's will is that all people be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth

Note: we must pray God's will for all the names we wrote down in that book.

John 6:44

44For no one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws them to me, and at the last day I will raise them up.

We pray that God draw the lost. Draw them in a 5 mile radius around HTBC. Draw our relatives, bosses, coworker etc.

Powerpoint: Every time we Pray God's will He says Yes and amen

2 Cor.1:20KJV

For all the promises of God in him *are* yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us.

4. We Pray God's will in Faith

Mark 11:24TPT

This is the reason I urge you to boldly believe for whatever you ask for in prayer—be convinced that you have received it and it will be yours

5. We pray God's will in tongues

Romans 8:26-27

26And the Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness. For example, we don't know what God wants us to pray for. But the Holy Spirit prays for us with groanings that cannot be expressed in words. 27And the Father who knows all hearts knows what the Spirit is saying, for the Spirit pleads for us believers in harmony with God's own will.
