THE PRAYERS THAT ALWAYS RECEIVE ANSWERS

We pray from a position of predetermined victory. God tells us the answer before we pray, but we give Him the legal right to do it in our lives or on earth. WE PRAY GOD'S WILL BE DONE ON EARTH

Matthew 6:10 KJVS - Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

*DANIEL READ THÈ WORD (WILL) AND PRAYED THE WORD (WILL)

Daniel 9:2-4,19 NLT

During the first year of his reign, I, Daniel, learned from reading the word of the LORD, as revealed to Jeremiah the prophet, that Jerusalem must lie desolate for seventy years. [3] So I turned to the Lord God and pleaded with him in prayer and fasting. I also wore rough burlap and sprinkled myself with ashes. [4] I prayed to the LORD my God and confessed: "O Lord, you are a great and awesome God! You always fulfill your covenant and keep your promises of unfailing love to those who love you and obey your commands. [19] "O Lord, hear. O Lord, forgive. O Lord, listen and act! For your own sake, do not delay, O my God, for your people and your city bear your name."

PRAYING IN RIGHT STANDING WITH GOD

James 5:16 AMP - The heartfelt and persistent prayer of a righteous man (believer) is able to accomplish much.

1 Peter 3:12 NLT

The eyes of the LORD watch over those who do right, and his ears are open to their prayers. But the LORD turns his face against those who do evil."

Proverbs 15:29 KJVS - 29 The LORD is far from the wicked: but he heareth the prayer of the righteous.

PRAYING IN THE NAME OF JESUS

WE RECEIVE THE SAME RESULTS JESUS GOT WHEN HE PRAYED

John 11:41-42 NIrV - Father, I thank you for hearing me. 42 I know that you always hear me.

John 16:23 ESV - Truly, truly, I say to you, whatever you ask of the Father in my name, he will give it to you.

John 16:24 ESV - Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.

PRAYING GOD'S WILL

1 John 5:14-15 KJVS

And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: [15] And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

Romans 8:26 NLT

And the Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness. For example, we don't know what God wants us to pray for. But the Holy Spirit prays for us with groanings that cannot be expressed in words.

*WE DON'T PRAY GOD YOU KNOW WHAT'S BEST. I JUST NEED A BLESSING

Philippians 4:6 KJVS

Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

PRAYERS THAT AGREE WITH THIS IS GOD'S WILL. 3 John 1:2 KJVS

Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

PRAYING IN THE SPIRIT (What Holy Spirit reveals to you)

Ephesians 6:18 KJVS

Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

PRAYING IN FAITH - NOT HOPING & PRAYING

Mark 11:24 KJVS

Therefore I say unto you, what things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

James 1:5-8 ESV

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him. [6] But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea that is driven and tossed by the wind. [7] For that person must not suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; [8] he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

PRAYER OF AGREEMENT

Matthew 18:19 KJVS

Again I say unto you, that if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.

MINISTRY TO YOUR SPOUSE

1 Peter 3:7 TPT

Husbands, you in turn must treat your wives with tenderness, viewing them as feminine partners who deserve to be honored, for they are co-heirs with you of the "divine grace of life," so that nothing will hinder your prayers.

PERSISTENT PRAYERS (Refuse to accept anything but the request)

Luke 18:6-8 TPT

Jesus continued, "Did you hear what the godless judge said—that he would answer her persistent request? [7] Don't you know that God, the true judge, will grant justice to all his chosen ones who cry out to him night and day? He will pour out his Spirit upon them. He will not delay to answer you and give you what you ask for. [8] God will give swift justice to those who don't give up. So be ever praying, ever expecting, in the same way as the widow. Even so, when the Son of Man comes back, will he find this kind of undying faith on earth?"
